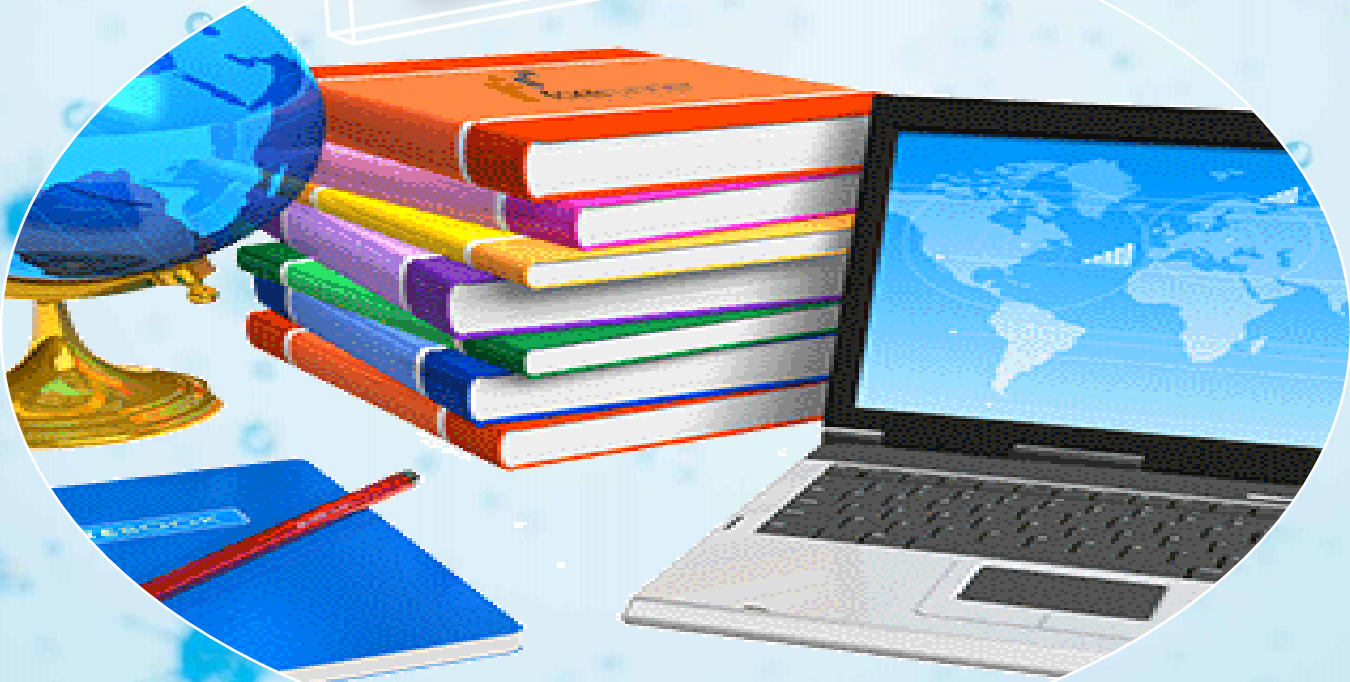

With a wish to see you all, always remain in the same happy state as you all were in our lap, till we close our eyes...

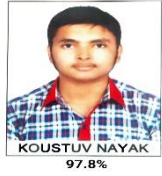

SAFE AT HOME

Here's what you can do to keep yourself safe

① Wash hands frequently

Scrub backs of hands, between fingers and under nails for at least 20 seconds with soap and water or alcohol-based hand rub to kill viruses.

② Avoid crowded places

When someone coughs or sneezes, they release small liquid droplets from their nose or mouth that may contain virus. If you are too close, you can breathe in the droplets, including the COVID-19 virus.

③ Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth

Hands touch many surfaces and can pick up viruses. Once contaminated, hands can transfer the virus to your eyes, nose or mouth. From there, the virus can enter your body.

④ Practice respiratory hygiene

Droplets spread virus. By following good respiratory hygiene, you protect the people around you from viruses.

⑤ Wear a mask if you have respiratory symptoms

Mask isn't required to be worn by all. Only those with respiratory symptoms (coughing or sneezing) need to use it to protect others from getting the virus. If you use a mask, make sure it is disposed of properly.

WOMEN'S LIBERATION IN INDIA

Since the previous century onwards, a deep concern over the rights and statues of women has marked the Indian political thinking. The impetus was provided by Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi who had categorically stated, "Woman is the companion of man, gifted with equal mental capacities. She has the right to participate in every minute detail in the activities of man and she has equal right of freedom and liberty with him... "

Why should men have all the Privileges? Why is there no equality among the citizens? Our Nari Shakti which was regarded as next to God, is now downtrodden, starved and relegated to the lowest rung of statues in Indian society. In our constitution it is clearly mentioned that women should have gender equality in the matters of economic, social and political significance as a fundamental Right to Indian women, who roughly form one sixth of the world's female population.

India is one of the few countries which have a highly creditable record with respect to the enactment in laws to protect and promote the interest of women. Many legislations have been passed in the For of women. For example; Dowry prohibition Act, Marriage and Succession Act of different religious groups, Immoral Traffic prevention act, etc. These laws, however, are not effective enough as they were expected to be. Reports of child marriages, dowry harassment and molestation at workplaces bear a glaring testimony to these observations. The reservation of women in the Lok Sabha to the tune of 33% was scrapped politely by the male chauvinist parliaments several times, during the last decades in Lok Sabha, however it was passed in Rajya Sabha in March 2010. The bill which proposes to provide 33% reservation of all seats is unfortunately pending. Several programs like Mahila Samridhi Yojana and Rashtriya Mahila Kosh have been set up to encourage the habit of thrift among rural women and provide credit in the informal sector. The 73rd amendment of Constitution in 1992 had reserved one- third of seats for women in Panchayati Raj Institutions. Nearly 15.3 % of the total workers in organised sectors are women. The literacy rate of women has been increasing tremendously during the last century. It jumped from 0.60% in 1901 to 65.46% till today. During the last 3 decades, several voluntary organisations and NGOs have come into existence in the country. They are mobilising women by making them aware of their rights and preparing them for collective actions.

The Indian woman of the new millennium would take care of her family, children and spouse. She would also work hard in offices and factories. She would also work as a doctor, engineer. She can also become a civil servant and serve in the army. Tomorrow belongs to her as she has already achieved many landmarks.

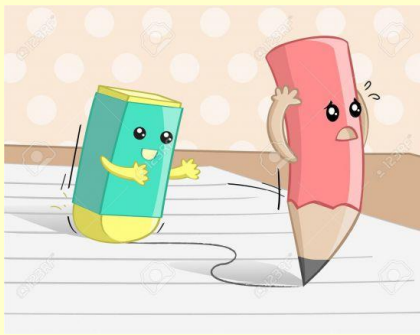

According to article 24 a child under 14 years cannot be employed to perform any hazardous work. Such exploitation is prohibited by legislation worldwide, although these laws do not consider all work by children as child labour; exceptions include work by child artists, family duties, supervised training, and some forms of child work practiced by Amish children, as well as by indigenous children. The phenomena of child labour is quite complex. Children work because they belong to poor families who cannot survive without the benefit of income which accrues to the family on account of child labour. Any attempt to abolish it through legal recourse would under the circumstances not be practical. Recycling paper

Paper recycling pertains to the processes of processing waste paper for reuse. Waste papers are either obtained from paper mills, paper scraps, discarded paper materials and waste paper material discarded after consumer use. Examples of the commonly known papers recycled are old newspapers and magazines. Recycling paper has several benefits both for humans and the earth. Using recycled paper to make new paper reduces the number of trees that are cut down, conserving natural resources. Recycling paper saves landfill space and reduces the amount of pollution in the air from incineration. To recycle, soak the waste paper in warm water for 4–6 hours. Blend the paper for at least 30 seconds to turn it into pulp. You can pinch glitter to the slurry to make your paper sparkle. Now fill a large pan at least one-third of the way full with warm tap water. Pour the blended slurry into the pan. Stir the slurry into the water until it's an even consistency. Immerse the screened frame in the pulp mixture. Lift up the screen until it is above the water. Transfer the wet sheet of paper to a soft, absorptive surface. Lift the screen up and away from the transferred paper. Peel the paper off the screen if it hasn't transferred to the towels. Set the paper out to dry overnight or hit it to do it faster. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has found that recycling causes 35% less water pollution and 74% less air pollution than making virgin paper. Pulp mills can be sources of both air and water pollution, especially if they are producing bleached pulp.

4) Appointing special judges for Fast Track Courts.

The government must not appoint the present judges as the judges of Fast Track courts in order to reduce burden on the existing system.

5) Establishing special institutions for the appointment of judges across all the Courts established by Constitution.

This institution would work with the collegium system of India in filling the vacancies pending in the country across all the courts. And its members would be appointed by the Chief Justice of India and other judges of the court.

6) Encouraging the youth

The people should themselves take interest in solving the problems of the country and its judicial system.

7) Using Technology

Use of tablets and other such electronic gadgets to minimise the use of paper.

8) Protection to Judges

There should be an independent agency like CBI which would respond to the threats given to the judges by the criminals, in order to protect the judges against such elements.

By taking such measures we can solve the problems of the Judiciary to some extent which would in turn help the judicial system in delivering justice to everyone on time.

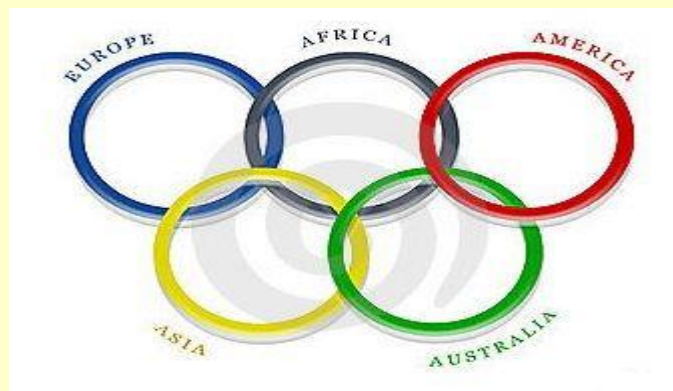

ARE STUDENTS REALLY LEARNING DURING COVID-19? FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT AT APPROPRIATE LEVEL CAN PROVIDE THE ANSWER

All of a sudden, the schools around the world have closed due to coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Students, teachers, and parents are settling into the "new reality" for their foreseeable future in the field of education. Many schools are implementing their distance learning contingency plans (some of them put together recently), and connecting students and teachers through online platforms, virtual modes of education and tools. National and local governments are partnering with broadcasting service providers to deliver educational content via television, YouTube channel, popular newspapers and radio during dedicated hours. Under these unexpected circumstances, teachers and parents have had to quickly adapt to teaching in this new reality to ensure that students really engage themselves in learning.

What are the learning assessments challenges and priorities in the current context?

Assessment of student learning is "the process of gathering and evaluating information on what students know, understand, and can do in order to make an informed decision about the next steps in the educational process. Learning assessment is a fundamental feedback mechanism in education, allowing all stakeholders of the learning process to understand what is being learned and where learning resources need to be focused. Assessment may take different modalities depending on its purpose. Along with high-stakes examinations and large-scale assessments, formative assessment is, under normal circumstances, carried out by teachers in the classroom as part of the teaching process and encompasses everything from teacher observation to continuous feedback to homework. Formative assessment is particularly relevant to understand the learning needs of each and every student and to adjust instruction accordingly. In addition, teachers usually implement summative assessments whereby specific educational content is reviewed to determine the extent to which students reached the expected learning goals and acquired critical knowledge and skills.

Prior to the COVID-19 crisis, all modalities of learning assessment had been strongly dependent on students' physical presence – either for administration or for observing the learners' daily progress. Current school closures necessitate development of alternative approaches to delivering the critical feedback function of learning assessment. While all types of assessment of student learning are important, the need for formative assessment right now is particularly critical because learning needs to take place outside of the physical classroom, teachers and parents-turned-teachers need to understand whether students are really absorbing, understanding and applying the content that is delivered to them in formats that differ from business-as-usual.

How can formative assessment support learning in the context of school closures?

Formative assessment can be administered in synchronous and asynchronous forms. In the synchronous form, where the teacher and the student are working together at the same time (via online platforms like Zoom, and Microsoft Teams and others), as well as directly by phone, teachers can provide feedback to students in real time. In the asynchronous form, where students and teachers are separated by both space and time, online tools such as Google Classrooms, WhatsApp and Moodle can help teachers to provide feedback to students through questions, tasks, activities, and quizzes. Various online applications such as Recap, Video Response and Reflection for Education, WURRLY Edu, and Screencast can be used to record performance tasks created by students and shared with teachers. Especially for younger students, parents also need specific guidance on how to communicate the results of formative assessment to teachers. These instructions should be made available in electronic and/or printed form and emailed homes or made available for pickup from the school or other designated location.

Even in low-resource and low-connectivity contexts, formative assessment can happen during school closures. Teachers can provide feedback to students through mailed instructions and tasks. Messaging platforms (such as Messenger and WhatsApp) can also be used: companies are making available solutions that allow teachers to design, deliver, and track multiple-choice and short answer assessments through text messaging. Direct phone calls between teachers, students, and parents can also be utilized even under lockdowns. Irrespective of how formative assessment is communicated, it needs to be valid, timely, constructive, and specific to the learning needs of the child. The validity element is linked to the alignment of assessment content with the knowledge content the student should have acquired as part of the learning process. The timeliness aspect refers to the opportune use of the assessment to take quick action and provide remedial support if needed. The constructiveness element refers to the assessment's capacity to deliver feedback to the student and

For the student to gain information that helps him or her identify misunderstandings, get guidance on how to improve, and understand the goals of the learning process. Finally, the specificity of formative assessment implies its ability to inform teachers and students about whether specific learning goals are being reached, and what is needed in case they are not there yet. Teachers and parents need to be empowered with resources and means to conduct formative assessment in line with these elements, even in low-resource environments.

Various resources can be used by teachers and parents to support formative assessment in the context of COVID-19, and companies are making their tools more available to a broad range of users during this time (however, in choosing any specific tool, it is important to check the contract terms and confirm that its use is in line with all applicable laws and regulations). At the same time, it is also to be checked whether that particular resource is actually useful for our students or not. In low-resource contexts, where connectivity and access to smart devices cannot be taken for granted, printed materials can be developed to support early reading skills for young children, and to provide support for teachers and families.

Even though in many places it is currently not possible for teachers and students to come together in the same space, it is necessary for teaching and learning to continue to avoid learning losses and to stay on track in decreasing learning poverty. Formative assessment can help all students to continue along their learning trajectory, providing them, their parents, and their teachers with the necessary information to support the learning process, even from a distance.

Nuclear Chain reaction and Corona Chain

Which one is more devastating?!

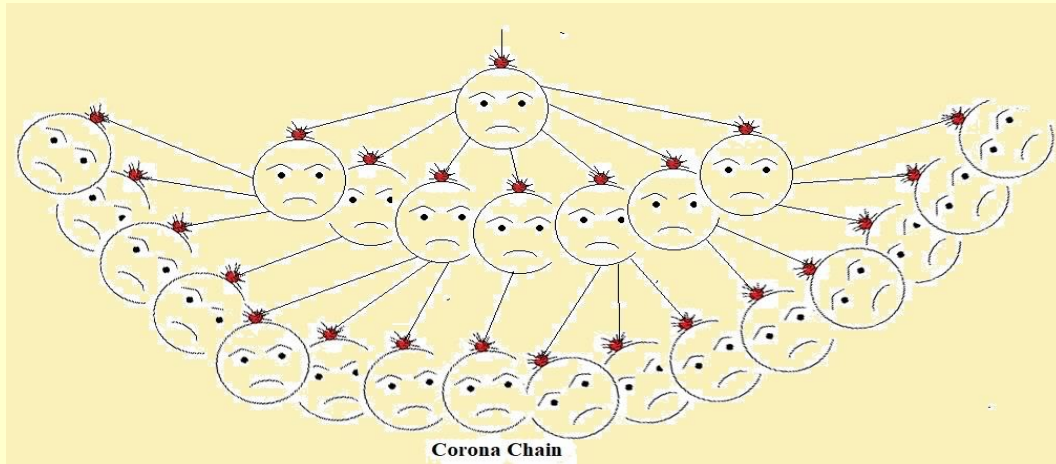
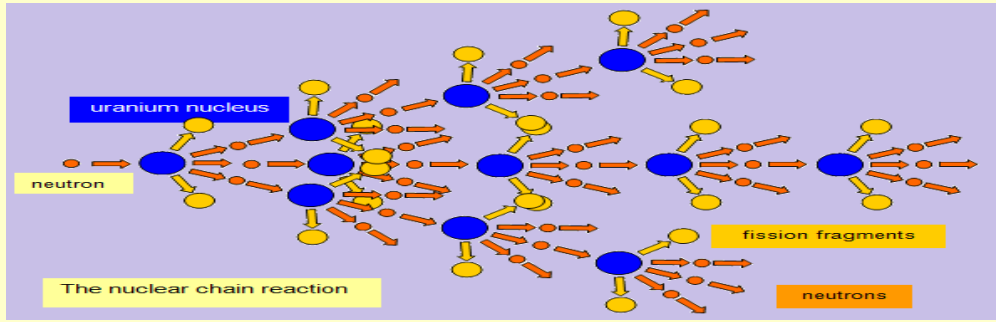
Nuclear fission and nuclear fusion are energy-generating processes. Nuclear fusion is responsible for the production of energy in the Sun. In nuclear fission, a heavy nucleus splits into two or more fragments of nearly equal sizes, releasing a tremendous quantity of energy; however, to begin artificial fission, a slow neutron is bombarded on a heavy nucleus, breaking it into fragments with some neutrons and releasing energy. Fission of one nucleus of a heavy atom (Uranium nucleus) produces around three neutrons. These three neutrons induce the fission of three nuclei, resulting in the production of nine neutrons. These 9 neutrons trigger fission, resulting in the production of 27 neutrons... The process proceeds with 81 neutrons... 243 neutrons... and so on. This occurs in an uncontrolled way, resulting in the release of a vast amounts of energy. This sort of uncontrolled chain reaction produces enormous amounts of energy, which causes the destruction in atom bomb explosions.

Multiplication factor, $K = \frac{\text{No. of fission produced in one step}}{\text{No. of fissions in the preceding generation.}}$

The chain reaction is said to be supercritical if $K > 1$. To produce a catastrophic explosion, a large quantity of energy is generated in a short period of time ($\sim 10^{-7}$ s).

This uncontrolled fission is comparable to the propagation of the Corona virus but in a far deadlier way. It's because one individual can uncontrollably spread 1, 2, 3, or even more than 100 people.

It follows a geometric progression in uncontrolled fission, 1:3:9:27:81...., but the spread of the corona virus is extremely dangerous. It might go in a random order like 1:5:9: 20:100.... As a result, it is in a life-or-death scenario. Similar to absorbents (cadmium rods) used to regulate chain reactions, protective measures can stop the corona chain.



The corona chain is incredibly hazardous and destructive! Let us take precautions to break the corona chain.

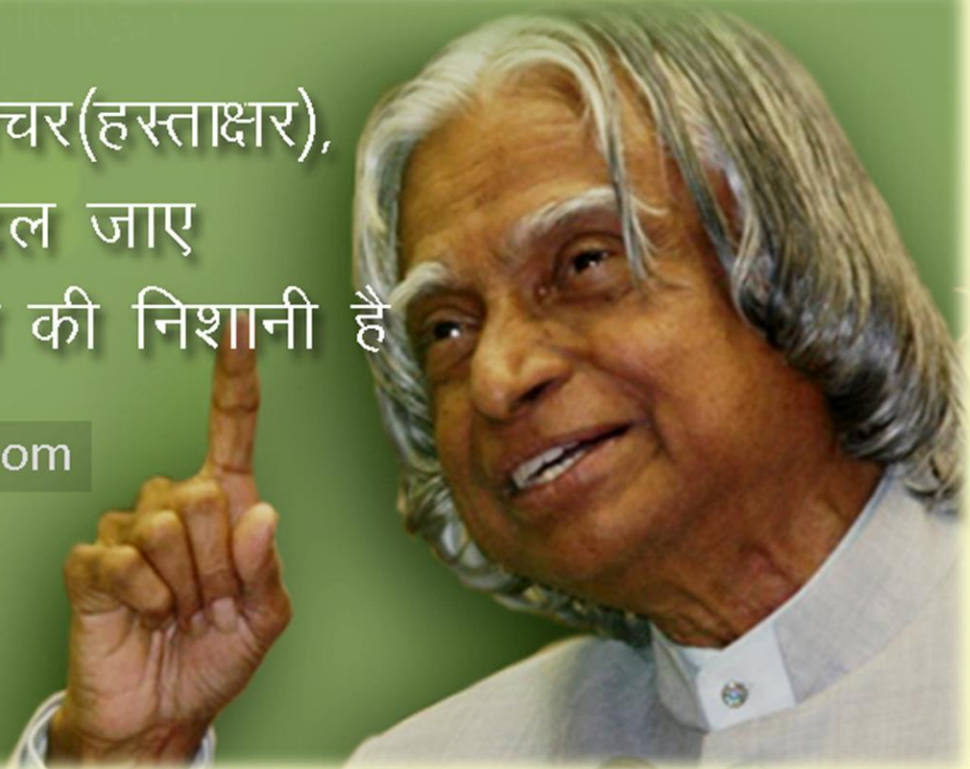

असफलताएं हमें जीवन का सबसे अच्छा सबक सिखाती हैं। इस तथ्य से कोई इंकार नहीं कर सकता कि जीवन वास्तव में एक धीमा संघर्ष है। कभी-कभी, किसी को आश्चर्य होता है कि वे इसे अगले दिन तक बना सकते हैं या नहीं। असफलता पर इस निबंध में सफलता का स्तंभ है; कोई सीखता है कि जीवन असफलताओं और सफलता दोनों का स्वाद देता है।

वह अंत में 65 वर्ष की आयु में सफल होता है, जिसे कई लोगों के लिए सेवानिवृत्ति माना जाता है। जब 1000 से ज्यादा लोगों ने उनकी रेसिपी को ठुकरा दिया तो उन्हें बुरा नहीं लगा। इसके बजाय, वह अपने नुस्खा और खुद पर विश्वास करता था।

दृढ़ पर विश्वास और विश्वास भी व्यक्ति को सफल होने में मदद करता है। यह सिर्फ यह दिखाने के लिए जाता है कि दृढ़ संकल्प, समर्पण और महत्वाकांक्षा क्या कर सकती है। असफलताएं अधिक जोश, ऊर्जा और तैयारी के साथ वापस आने का एक और अवसर देती हैं।

इसने उसे बुरी तरह कुचल दिया होगा। लेकिन उन्होंने इसे मानसिक रूप से प्रभावित नहीं होने दिया। उन्होंने अपनी फर्म शुरू की। इस तरह Apple का जन्म हुआ। आज के बाजार में इसकी कुल संपत्ति \$2 ट्रिलियन है। कई असफलताओं के बाद प्राप्त सफलता कीमती और मूल्यवान होती है।

यह व्यक्ति के दृढ़ संकल्प और धैर्य के लिए उबलता है। यही उन्हें सफलता की राह पर ले जाता है। हां, जीत का रास्ता आत्म-संदेह, अंतहीन पीड़ा, शारीरिक तनाव, भावनात्मक भय से भरा है।

लेकिन जब लक्ष्य प्राप्त हो जाता है तो वह सब गायब हो जाता है।

आप ओपरा विनफ्रे से सीख सकते हैं। उसे समाचार रिपोर्टिंग की नौकरी से निकाल दिया गया था क्योंकि उसमें कोई रचनात्मकता नहीं थी। वह सबसे लोकप्रिय टीवी शो की होस्ट बनीं।

यहां तक कि खेल हस्तियों की भी विफलताओं का अपना हिस्सा रहा है। इस असफलता में सफलता का स्तम्भ है पैराग्राफ; गोरान इवानसेविच के बारे में पता चलता है, जो विंबलडन में पुरुष एकल जीतने वाले एकमात्र वाइल्डकार्ड थे।

शिक्षा सभी के लिए मुफ्त होनी चाहिए



शिक्षा की ट्यूशन लागत तेजी से ऊंची कीमतों पर आसमान छू रही है, क्या परिवार अपने बच्चों को कॉलेज भेज पाएंगे?

आने वाले वर्षों और वर्षों में अर्थव्यवस्था में नाटकीय रूप से बदलाव के साथ, ट्यूशन और शिक्षा प्राप्त करने की कीमतें पूरे देश में आसमान छू रही हैं। इसने देश भर में कई परिवारों को आर्थिक रूप से संघर्ष करने का कारण बना दिया है और उन्हें यह चुनना है कि अपने बच्चों को अच्छी शिक्षा के लिए कॉलेज भेजना है या नहीं। इसके

साथ ही कहा जा रहा है कि कुछ बदलने की जरूरत है ताकि परिवार उस संसाधन का किफायती उपयोग कर सकें, इसलिए "लोगों के लिए कम लागत पर अच्छी शिक्षा देने का सबसे अच्छा तरीका क्या है?"

मुझे लगता है कि यह नाटकीय रूप से उन बच्चों के साथ कई परिवारों को प्रभावित करेगा जिन्होंने अभी-अभी हाई स्कूल में स्नातक किया है और उच्च शिक्षा हासिल करना चाहते हैं। नौकरी उद्योग में एक अच्छा करियर बनाने के लिए कई कंपनियों के लिए मानक के रूप में उच्च शिक्षा की आवश्यकता होती है। अगर शिक्षा की कीमतों में बदलाव होता है, तो इसका असर सभी पर पड़ेगा क्योंकि लोग इसे आसानी से वहन करने में सक्षम होंगे।

हमारी शिक्षा में यह बदलाव क्यों होना चाहिए, इसके कुछ कारण यह है कि बहुत से लोग छात्र ऋण के कारण कर्ज में नहीं रहना चाहते हैं क्योंकि एफएएफएसए और अन्य निगम अपने पैसे उधार लेने के लिए उस शुल्क को पसंद करते हैं। यह पैसा इतनी बड़ी दर से अर्जित किया जा रहा है कि अधिकांश लोग इसे वहन करने में सक्षम नहीं हैं। इस तरह के प्रभाव से लोग दिवालिया हो सकते हैं और भारी मात्रा में ऋण के कारण वित्तीय क्षति हो सकती है जिसे छात्रों से एकत्र करने की आवश्यकता होती है।

छात्रों के पास अपनी पढ़ाई पर ध्यान केंद्रित करने और अपनी डिग्री का पीछा करने के लिए अधिक समय होगा, बजाय इसके कि एकल की अवधि के लिए भुगतान कैसे किया जाए। यह लोगों को समय पर स्नातक होने और नौकरी उद्योग में कार्य क्षेत्र में आगे बढ़ने की अनुमति देगा।

जैसा कि कुछ लोग कह सकते हैं कि सामर्थ्य एक कारण है कि शिक्षा मुफ्त होनी चाहिए, अन्य सहमत हैं कि हमारी अर्थव्यवस्था के लिए उच्च शिक्षित होना बेहतर है और यदि आप इस मानक को पूरा नहीं करते हैं, तो आपके लिए एक निश्चित खर्च वहन करने में सक्षम होने के अवसर बहुत सीमित हैं। जीवन शैली। एक ऐसा अवसर जिससे प्रत्येक मनुष्य को अपनी पूर्ण क्षमता तक पहुँचने का समान अधिकार हो।

दुनिया तेजी से बदल रही है जिसके लिए ज्ञान आधारित या उन्नत कौशल रखने वाले लोगों द्वारा रोजमर्रा के काम करने की आवश्यकता है।

यह एक बेहतर शिक्षित रोजगार उद्योग का विचार पैदा करता है जो हमारे आर्थिक विकास को बढ़ाने में मदद करेगा।

हालांकि...

मानव प्रौद्योगिकी की बढ़ती दर से बढ़ने के साथ हमें जल्द ही पता चल जाएगा कि कई कंपनियों के साथ उद्योग मानक रोबोट के साथ मानव श्रम को कम करते हैं जो रोजमर्रा के कार्यों को करने में सक्षम हैं। यह सीईओ को पेरोल की राशि के साथ पैसे बचाने की अनुमति देता है जो उन्हें अपना काम करने वाले लोगों को देना होगा।

इसके साथ समस्या?

इससे बहुत से लोग मानव जीवन शैली जीने के लिए रोजमर्रा की जरूरतों को पूरा करने में सक्षम नहीं होंगे। इस जीवनशैली के लिए लोगों को अपनी प्रतिभा, कौशल और नए विचारों का परीक्षण करने की स्वतंत्रता की आवश्यकता होती है और इससे लोग खुश होंगे। अधिक खुश लोगों के साथ यह एक समृद्ध आबादी की ओर ले जाएगा।

एक और कारण है कि एक मुफ्त शिक्षा फायदेमंद है कि सरकार संसाधनों को बर्बाद कर रही है। संसाधनों की शक्ति जो चिकित्सा खोजों, अर्थव्यवस्था और प्रौद्योगिकी की उन्नति को जन्म दे सकती है। इन लाभों के साथ यह हमारे देश को अन्य देशों पर एक लाभ के रूप में उच्च शक्ति की क्षमता रखने की अनुमति देगा क्योंकि विभिन्न सरकारों के बीच गठबंधन इस दुनिया की संस्कृति के लिए आवश्यक है।

ओईसीडी में शिक्षा और कौशल निदेशालय के निदेशक "डिबेटिंग यूरोप" के एक लेख में, एंड्रियास श्लीचर बताते हैं, "महत्वपूर्ण बात यह है कि सबसे अच्छे और प्रतिभाशाली लोगों की विश्वविद्यालय तक पहुंच है, न कि केवल सबसे धनी लोगों की। वहीं, किसी न किसी को इसकी कीमत चुकानी पड़ती है। इसलिए, हमें जनता, सरकार और नियोक्ताओं के बीच लागत और लाभों को साझा करने का एक तरीका खोजने की जरूरत है, इसलिए यह वास्तव में सबसे अच्छा और प्रतिभाशाली है जिसे विश्वविद्यालय में सबसे अच्छे स्थान मिलेंगे..." बिना किसी शुल्क के यह गारंटी की अनुमति देता है उच्च शिक्षा के माध्यम से विकास।

इतने सारे कारणों से सूची इस विचार का समर्थन करने के लिए आगे बढ़ सकती है कि उच्च शिक्षा सभी के लिए मुफ्त क्यों होनी चाहिए। अफोर्डेबिलिटी, आर्थिक विकास, चिकित्सा खोजों और प्रौद्योगिकी की उन्नति जैसे विचार ट्यूशन-रहित शिक्षा के कुछ लाभ हैं। जनसंख्या के उच्च शिक्षित होने से इससे पूरी दुनिया को लाभ होगा और मानव जीवन के विकास में वृद्धि होगी। हालांकि यह

बाल श्रम

बच्चों को कम उम्र में वयस्कों की तरह काम करने के लिए मजबूर किया जाता है; इस अधिनियम को बाल श्रम कहा जाता है। यह बस छोटे बच्चों के बचपन को समाप्त कर देता है। इससे छोटे बच्चों को शारीरिक, सामाजिक और नैतिक नुकसान होता है। बलपूर्वक नियोजित किए जाने वाले बच्चों की संख्या भारत में ज्ञात नहीं है। बच्चों को कभी-कभी खराब कामकाजी परिस्थितियों और अपर्याप्त मजदूरी, भोजन या आराम के तहत काम करने के लिए मजबूर किया जाता है। कई बच्चे शारीरिक, यौन, मानसिक और भावनात्मक रूप से प्रभावित होते हैं।

भारत में बाल श्रम मुख्य रूप से देश की गरीबी के कारण देखा जाता है, जो एक अन्य कारण भी होता है, जो कि खराब स्कूली शिक्षा के अवसर हैं। बाल श्रम के शिकार ग्रामीण और शहरी दोनों क्षेत्रों में आते हैं। 2011 की जनगणना रिपोर्ट के अनुसार, 5-14 वर्ष की आयु के बीच भारत की जनसंख्या 259.6 मिलियन है। इनमें से 10.1 बच्चे बाल श्रम के शिकार हैं। रिपोर्ट्स के मुताबिक करीब 40 फीसदी बच्चे ज्वैलरी कटिंग के क्षेत्र में काम करते हैं। खनन, रेस्तरां, चाय की दुकान, कढ़ाई जैसे कई उद्योग बच्चों को रोजगार देते हैं। उन्हें कुछ घरों में घरेलू श्रम के रूप में भी पाया जा सकता है।

सरकारी अधिकारियों और संगठनों को बाल श्रम के खिलाफ एकजुट होना चाहिए और बच्चों को इसके तहत होने वाले शोषण और अत्याचार से मुक्त करना चाहिए।
